IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO SHAREHOLDERS REGARDING THE COMPANY'S ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING TO BE HELD ON 30 JUNE 2020

The Board of Directors (the "**Board**") of CDW Holding Limited (the "**Company**", and together with its subsidiaries, the "**Group**") refers to:

- (a) its announcements of 22 April 2020 and 21 May 2020 on the obtaining of the SGX's approval and update for the time extension to hold its annual general meeting ("**AGM**") by 30 June 2020;
- (b) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) Act 2020 passed by Parliament on 7 April 2020 which enables the Minister for Law by order to prescribe alternative arrangements for listed companies in Singapore to, inter alia, conduct general meetings, either wholly or partly, by electronic communication, video conferencing, tele-conferencing or other electronic means;
- (c) the COVID-19 (Temporary Measures) (Alternative Arrangements for Meetings for Companies, Variable Capital Companies, Business Trusts, Unit Trusts and Debenture Holders) Order 2020 (the "Order") which was gazetted on 13 April 2020, and which sets out the alternative arrangements in respect of, inter alia, general meetings of companies; and
- (d) the announcement by the Singapore Government on 19 May 2020 that when the circuit breaker period ends on 1 June 2020, the safe-distancing measures will be gradually eased and business and social activities will be allowed to resume safely in a 3-phased manner to minimise the risk of community transmission of COVID-19 in Singapore. Phase One (Safe Re-Opening) will be implemented from 2 June 2020 and is expected to last at least four weeks. Businesses are allowed to resume activities in Phase One are required to comply with the sector-specific advisories, requirements and Safe Management Measures at Workplaces as announced by the Ministry of Manpower. Non-essential activities and social activities/gatherings will remain prohibited under Phase One.

In light of the evolving Covid-19 situation and the above developments, the Company wishes to announce that:

1. Date, time and conduct of AGM. The Company is pleased to announce that pursuant to the Order, its AGM will be convened and be held by way of electronic means, on Tuesday, 30 June 2020 at 3.00 p.m. (Singapore time).

The Company will conduct the proceedings of the AGM broadcasted "live" through an audio-andvideo webcast and an audio-only feed and address substantial and relevant questions which Shareholders have submitted in advance.

- 2. Notice of AGM and Proxy Form. The Notice of AGM and Proxy Form will be sent to Shareholders by electronic means via publication on SGXNet and on the Company's website at https://cdw-holding.com.hk/. Printed copies of these documents are also sent to Shareholders.
- 3. No personal attendance at AGM. Due to the current Covid-19 restriction orders in Singapore, Shareholders will not be able to attend the AGM in person.
- 4. **Participation at the AGM electronically.** Shareholders may participate at the AGM by:

(a) observing and/or listening to the AGM proceedings via live audio-visual webcast or live audio-only stream;

(b) submitting questions in advance of the AGM; and

(c) appointing the Chairman of the Meeting ("**Chairman**") as proxy to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the AGM.

Details of the steps for pre-registration, pre-submission of questions and voting at the AGM are set out in the Appendix to this announcement.

5. **Rejection of Proxy Forms.** The Company shall be entitled to reject the Proxy Form appointing the Chairman of the AGM as proxy if it is incomplete, improperly completed or illegible or where the true intentions of the appointer are not ascertainable from the instructions of the appointer specified in the instrument appointing or treated as appointing the Chairman of the AGM as proxy (including any related attachment).

In addition, in the case of depositors whose shares in the Company (the "**Shares**") are entered against their names in the Depository Register (as defined in Section 81SF of the Securities and Futures Act, Chapter 289 of Singapore), the Company may reject any instrument appointing the Chairman of the AGM as proxy lodged if such depositors are not shown to have Shares entered against their names in the Depository Register forty-eight (48) hours before the time appointed for holding the AGM as certified by The Central Depository (Pte) Limited to the Company.
